SEWER DISTRICT ENGINEER

This position reports to the District Director and is responsible for development and enforcement of the Logan County Sewer District's Engineering Requirements and Construction Standards; working with the District's GIS vendor to ensure assets are properly cataloged and located, reviewing site plans for residential, commercial and industrial development to determine compliance with Ohio EPA and Logan County Sewer District requirements; oversight of contractors installing, repairing and rehabilitating public and private sanitary sewer systems; designing sanitary sewer extensions and modifications; preparing specifications and documents necessary to place projects out for bid. In addition, this position is responsible for the oversight of the Field Services Group. Field Services Operator(s) perform inspections on new and repaired sanitary sewers, perform OUPS locates, GPS locate and categorizes public and private sanitary sewer assets and provides guidance to contractors and customers to ensure compliance with the Construction Standards

Minimum requirements include a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from and ABET accredited university; have a valid PE license or, at a minimum, be registered as an Engineer-Intern in the State of Ohio. Must possess a valid Ohio Driver License with a clean driving record and maintain qualifications for driving on county business at all times.

Hours for this position are normally Monday – Friday from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm. Annual salary for this position is \$67,765 to \$80,898 (\$32.58- \$38.89 per hour) depending on experience, qualifications and PE licensing.

The selected candidate must pass a criminal background check and drug screen. All positions are subject to a probationary period of 12 months. The County provides an excellent benefits package that include 2 weeks of vacation after the 1st year and regular increases thereafter based on years of service, sick leave, health insurance and prescription drug plan with options for supplemental (vision/dental) insurance and a pension program through Ohio Public Employees Retirement System.
